



Once you have used the MUSIC-*link* self-validation functionality for your MUSIC model and it either:

A) Meets the reportable parameter requirements for Port Stephens Council's setup configuration and targets, then;

STEP 1) Generate a Port Stephens Council MUSIC-*link* PDF report for submission with your model.

STEP 2) Submit your self-validated MUSIC model along with the Port Stephens Council MUSIC-*link* PDF report to Port Stephens Council as part of your Development Application.

All material submitted must be in accordance with Port Stephens Council DA submission requirements.

OR

B) The parameters and/or targets are outside the required ranges and you believe the use of these parameters or the output results can be justified, please follow the steps below:

STEP 1) Generate a Port Stephens Council MUSIC-*link* PDF report for submission with your model. **NOTE**: Any parameter breeches must be justified for the model to be considered by Port Stephens Council.

STEP 2) Provide reasons for model assumptions that are outside of default parameter ranges in the **Comments** section AND/OR

STEP 3) Submit your self-validated MUSIC model along with the Port Stephens Council MUSIC-*link* PDF report to Port Stephens Council as part of your Development Application.

All material submitted must be in accordance with Port Stephens Council DA submission requirements.

A successful self-validation check of your model does not constitute an approved model by Port Stephens Council
